• CHIEF OF POLICE JOHN LANDRETH

Councilman Keeney read aloud an email of which listed some inaccuracies regarding Chief John Landreth. Mr. Keeney stated Ms. Kandi Hubert has recommended the termination of Chief John Landreth prior to her resignation. Mr. Keeney also read aloud sections of the Police Departments manual. Mr. Keeney stated that he also expected the overtime, and all the overtime had been approved by the City Manager. Mr. Keeney asked Mayor Vasquez if the City Manager okayed the overtime, Mr. Vasquez stated yes she did.

Chief John Landreth stepped up to the podium and expressed his concerns regarding his item.

Mr. Keeney also informed the Council of the issue of citation not being brought to the Municipal Court due to the Police Dept. choosing to not bring citations to City Hall. Mr. Keeney stated even after the Council and City Manager had instructed the Police Dept. to submit the tickets to the Municipal Court they still chose to take them elsewhere.

Councilman Keeney motioned that the City Terminate John Landreth as Police Chief. There was no second. The motion died.

Councilman Garza stated he had concerns with trash in the parks. Possibly double the schedule of public works to pick up the trash around the parks and splash pad.
