Denise Hitt stated that the budget was not balanced correctly, Mrs. McKinney a property owner asks about multiple aspects of the budget. Mrs. Hitt stated that the 5.8 Million loan was partially toward the disannexed/Taft Southwest and that they should still be paying toward the I&S tax.

# 7. Mrs. Hitt asked what the average increase would mean for a tax payer in Taft. City Manager Smith pulled up the posting from the newspaper on the computer with the average increase per household listed. Mr. Searcy asked where the 3.5 million went.
